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About the College:

B. K. Birla College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), *Kalyan* a multi-faculty premier institution of higher learning, with an enrolment of more than 7,000 students (for UG, PG and Research Programmes) is affiliated to the University of Mumbai (UoM). In addition, more than 4000 students are enrolled in the Junior College in faculties of Arts, Commerce and Science.

Established in 1972, by the Kalyan Citizens' Education Society, with the blessings of Late Syt. B. K. Birla ji and Late Smt. Sarla ji Birla, the college bears a testimony to the principles of the house of Birla and stand true to its commitment of providing excellent higher education to the students while molding their character and encourage them to be ideal citizens of the country.

The College is spread over an area of 20 acres of land (including Birla School) in the prime location of Kalyan city and developed as an eco-friendly campus. The College is developing the infrastructure within the Campus to accommodate multi-disciplinary programmes which will benefit the student community, in particular and the society at large.

The College has been reaccredited (3rdCycle) in 2014 and awarded 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.58. The College has been the winner of IMC - RBNQ *Performance Excellence Trophy - 2011 in Education*. The College has been conferred with the '*Best College Award*' in the urban category, by the University of Mumbai in 2009. It is ISO 9001:2008 certified. The Recertification Audit of ISO 9001: 2008 was completed successfully by TUV-NORD in August 2016. College has started the process of upgradation for ISO 9001:2015.

The College has been bestowed with '*College of Excellence*' status (2015-2020) by UGC. Earlier the College was identified as '*College with Potential for Excellence*' (CPE) in 2010 by the UGC. It received a grant of Rs. 1.00 Cr. under CPE which has been utilized for improving academic infrastructure and adopting innovations in teaching, learning and evaluation. The College has again received a grant of Rs. 1.6 Cr. under CE from UGC.

The College also receives funds from DST under FIST scheme and from DBT under Star College scheme to strengthen teaching and research facilities in the departments of science faculty.



The RUSA has sanctioned our College a grant of Rs. 5.00 cr. for 'Enhancing Quality and Excellence'.

The College was granted the autonomous status by the UGC and the University of Mumbai in June 2018. The College formed the Board of Studies for each programme offered by the college, Board of Examinations for the evaluation process and the Academic Council for review of the syllabi and the various academic programmes offered by the College.

The college has been approved as a Potential 'Mentor Institution', by UGC under PARAMARSH scheme (2019-20).

The Management has made great efforts to provide affordable and accessible education to all the citizens of Kalyan. One such effort bore fruit when the Government and the University of Mumbai gave a sanction to start B. K. Birla Night College in the city of Kalyan. B. K. Birla Night College opened the admissions for the first year Arts, Commerce and Science for the academic year 2019-20. The mission of the Night College is to provide accessible and affordable higher education to those students who are unable to attend the day college due to various constraints. Government of Maharashtra vide GR dated 15th April, 2021 has accepted our proposal to start to start B. K. Birla Law College (3 Years Bachelor of Law) from the academic year 2021-22.

The year 2020 saw the whole world entering into a pandemic of Covid-19 and the country went into a lockdown since March 2020. The UGC and University of Mumbai issued various guidelines for the conduct of online examinations and online classes for the academic year 2020-21. The College responded to all the challenges remarkably with a strong support from the Management and the Staff members who rose to the challenge with complete dedication. The College management decided to use the online platform of Microsoft Teams for all online teaching-learning activities. The Schoolguru Qurio application was introduced for the conduct of online examinations.

- All the faculty members and staff attended the training conducted by Microsoft on O-365 (15 sessions from 16th April to 30th April 2020). These online sessions provided opportunity to all faculty members to get acquainted with Microsoft Office 365.
- Training sessions were conducted by the faculty members from Dept. of CS and IT and Teachers of Bifocal Department for the Faculty members, Staff and Teachers of Junior College.
- Training sessions were also conducted for the students of Degree College and Junior College for use of Microsoft Teams.



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Academic Performance (2019-20)

The College conducted the Semester VI examinations of undergraduate and Semester IV examinations of Post Graduate classes on behalf of the University of Mumbai, under the autonomous status in October 2020 in online mode using the Schoolguru Qurio application. Students were given training and mock tests beforehand and then the examinations were conducted for 60 marks using the Qurio application in October 2020 results were declared. The Internal assessment of 40 marks for most classes was completed before the lockdown. The students of our College have shown excellent academic performance (overall) in the Examinations held in October 2020.
